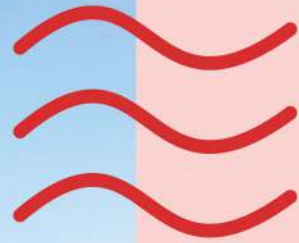

# CAP membership

- On 10 December 2020, Council endorsed the recommendations on the preferred process for the establishment of a CAP for the Takutai Kāpiti project.
- These recommendations included the process for CAP appointment.
- The recruitment consultancy JacksonStone & Partners was engaged to appoint the CAP Chair and community members.

# CAP Chair

- Advertising and shortlisting: March 2021
- The interview panel consisted of two elected Council members and a member of the Council's Senior Leadership Team.
- In April 2021, the former NZ Prime Minister and Waikanae resident, Rt Hon James Bolger ONZ PC, was appointed.

# CAP Community Members

- Advertising: April 2021
- The interview panel consisted of two elected Council members, the CAP Chair and a member of the Council's Senior Leadership Team.
- The successful candidates have been notified and are undergoing a final vetting process through Jackson Stone & Partners.
- Conflict of Interest forms will also be completed and induction packs provided to each member.

# CAP iwi membership

- In line with feedback from Te Whakaminenga o Kāpiti, the 10 December 2020 recommendations included:
  - the CAP membership will comprise of 6 iwi representatives.
  - the recognised iwi authorities will provide recommendations for the CAP iwi representative appointments.
- **29 June 2021** – ART Confederation Coastal Advisory Group hui to discuss the matters above.

- CAP commencement – late July 2021(date TBC)
